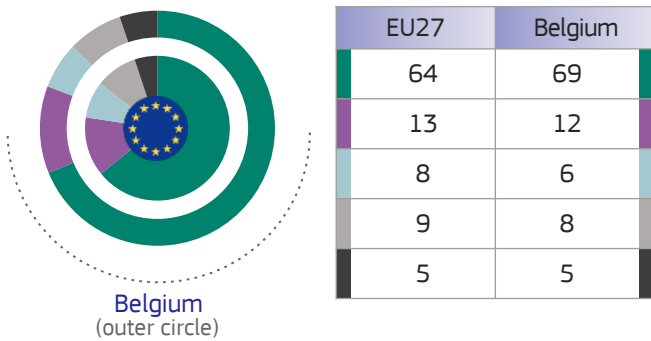

## 1 Intention to vote in the 2024 European elections

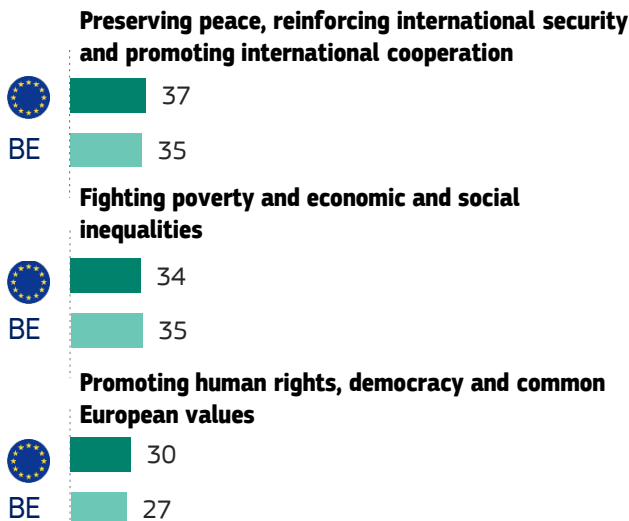
**Q13.** Do you intend to vote in the upcoming European elections? (%)

- Prefer not to answer

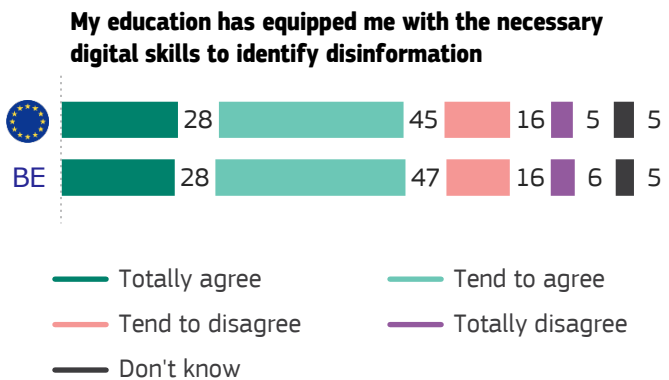
## 2 Youth's expectation from the EU

**Q12.** What do you expect of the European Union for your generation? You can select up to three answers. (% Top 3 responses)



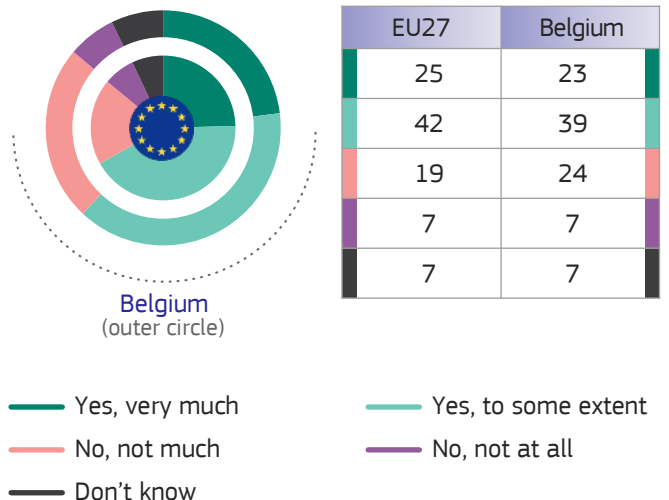

## 4 Impact of EU actions on daily life

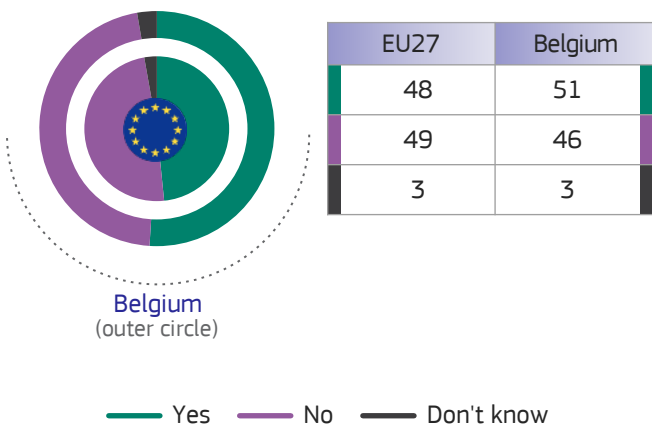
**Q11.** Would you say that actions taken by the EU have an impact on your daily life or not? (%)

- Don't know

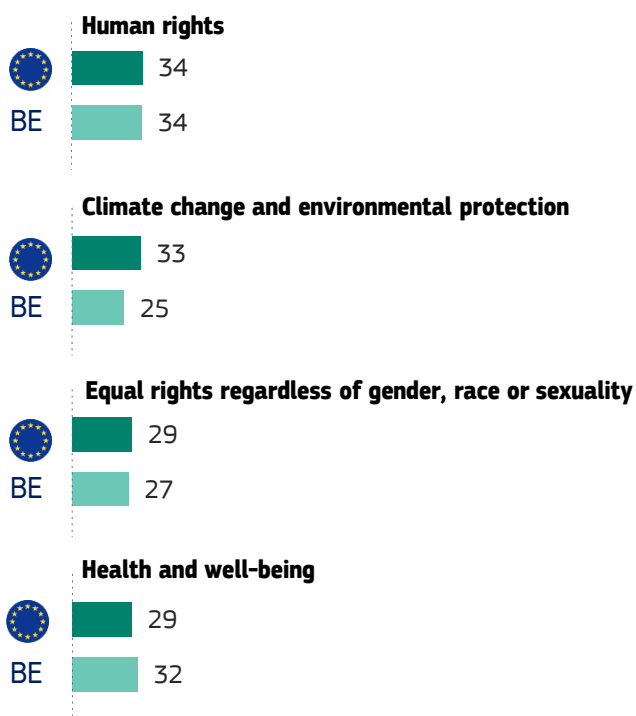
## 5 Civic engagement and societal change

**Q4a.** In the past year, have you taken any action to change society by, for example, signing a petition, participating in a rally, or sending a letter to a politician? (%)



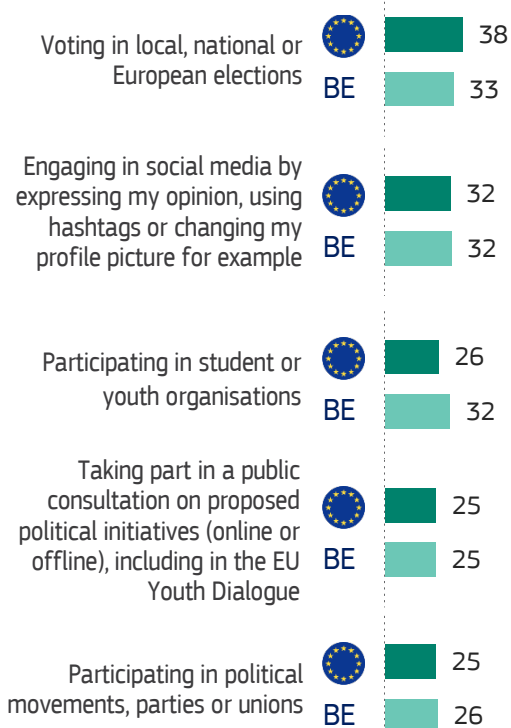
**Q4b.** In which areas did you try to change society (by, for example, signing a petition, participating in a rally, or sending a letter to a politician)? (% Top 4 responses)
